Applying for AMA membership:

Membership is contingent upon the American Medical Association's (AMA) acceptance of the membership application. The endorsement, deposit or negotiation of an applicant's check, or processing of a charge to applicant's credit card, does not guarantee admission into or acceptance of membership by the AMA.

AMA dues are not deductible as a charitable contribution for federal income tax purposes, but may be partially deducted as a business expense.

Dues-paying members are eligible to receive a print copy of the Journal of the American Medical Association. For the 2017 membership year, the allocated cost of \$31 for JAMA is included in, and not deductible from AMA membership dues.

Conditions of AMA membership and application:

As part of a physician organization committed to strengthening the ethics of medicine, every member

pledges to uphold the Principles of Medical Ethics as interpreted in the AMA Code of Medical Ethics, and to comply with the Bylaws of the American Medical Association and the Rules of the AMA Council on Ethical and Judicial Affairs.

Applicants and members are required to disclose to the AMA Office of General Counsel any violations of the Principles of Medical Ethics or unprofessional conduct including actions taken or pending regarding professional licensure, medical staff privileges, or felony or fraud convictions.

Terms and conditions for automatic renewal authorization:

Monthly installment payments with automatic renewal: Installment payments begin the month the membership transaction is made and continue until paid in full by December 31.

account will be charged 1/12 of the annual membership dues beginning January of each year.

Annual payment with automatic renewal: Your designated account will be charged immediately for the full amount of your annual membership dues. Thereafter, you will receive a reminder notice each year on or about November 1.

Physicians in a membership dues category that will transition at the time of renewal to a higher dues category will see the dues rates below at the time of renewal.
