Dr. Daviss is the president of the Maryland-DC Society of Addiction Medicine (MDDCSAM), past president of the Maryland Psychiatric Society (MPS), and is

medical director for Optum Maryland, which manages the Maryland Medicaid contract for specialty behavioral health services. He has founded three companies and currently advises start-ups in the mental health and addictions arena.
