John S. (Jack) McIntyre, M.D. is Clinical Professor of Psychiatry at the University of Rochester and Medical Director of HCR, a large home health care organization. Dr. McIntyre is Chair of the Board of Directors of PCPI, a national organization focusing on measurement science in medical care. Dr. McIntyre is the immediate past Chair of the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Health at Unity Health System

in Rochester, New York.

Dr. McIntyre is a past-President of the American Psychiatric Association. He was also Speaker of the APA Assembly and served in the Assembly for 25 years. Dr. McIntyre led the APA Practice Guideline project 1990-2008 and has chaired the Steering Committee of the APA Practice Research Network from 1992 to 2010. Dr. McIntyre chaired the Clinical and Public Health Committee of the DSM-5.
